# Re: Consultation on admission arrangements to St John Fisher Catholic Primary School for the year 2025–26

The Governing Body of St John Fisher Catholic Primary School is currently determining proposed admission arrangements for admissions to the primary school in September 2025.

As determined by the School Admissions Code, we are required to consult on these arrangements and are inviting comments on the proposed changes.

The Governing Body is proposing an amendment to the Admissions arrangements. From September 2025, they propose to:

- 1. To remove the requirement of a supplementary form
- 2. To remove the requirement of evidence of attending Mass regularly

#### Current Admissions Criteria

i Looked after Catholic children or looked after children in the care of Catholic families and previously looked after children who have been adopted or who have become the subject of a residence or guardianship order.

ii Baptised Catholic children resident within the parish of St. Benets and St John Fisher who attend Mass regularly; as verified by their Parish Priest;

III Baptised Catholic children resident in other Catholic parishes who attend Mass regularly; as verified by their Parish Priest

IV Other Baptised Catholic children resident in the Catholic parish of St. Benets and St John Fisher

V Other Baptised Catholic children resident in other Catholic parishes.

#### Proposed Admissions Criteria

- 1. Looked after Catholic children and all previously looked after Catholic children who have been adopted or who have become the subject of a child arrangement order or special guardianship order. Catholic children who appear (to the admissions authority) to have been in state care outside of England and cease to be in state care outside of England as a result of being adopted.
- 2. Baptised Catholic children. A baptismal certificate or evidence of reception into the Catholic Church must be provided.
- 3. Other looked after children and all previously looked after children who have been adopted or who have become the subject of a child arrangement order or special guardianship order. Children who appear (to the admissions authority) to have been in state care outside of England and cease to be in state care outside of England as a result of being adopted.
- 4. Children who are members of Eastern Orthodox Churches. Evidence of Baptism will be required
