


KEY STAGE 2 RESULTS 2014

All children across the country are assessed in Reading, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation (SPAG) and Maths through external tests at the end of year 6. Writing is assessed by teacher assessment. Each child is expected to achieve a Level 4 by the end of year 6 and the more able children a Level 5.




The points score in Mathematics (34.3) is a **very significant** improvement from 2013 (3.7) and is now **very significantly above** the national average (5.3)

The points score in Reading (30.2) is a fall from 2013 (1.4) and is now well above the national average (1.2)

The points score in Writing (30.0) is a slight improvement from 2013 (0.2) and remains significantly above the national average (2.1)

The points score in English Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling (EGPS) (34.3) is a **significant** improvement (3.9) and remains **significantly above** the national average (5.7)



All Pupils performed well above the national percentage at L4+ in Mathematics (11), well above in Reading (15), well above in Writing (15), significantly above in EGPS (24) and significantly above in Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined (21)
