


## KEY STAGE 2 RESULTS 2015

All children across the country are assessed in Reading, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation (SPAG) and Maths through external tests at the end of year 6. Writing is assessed by teacher assessment. Each child is expected to achieve a Level 4 by the end of year 6 and the more able children a Level 5.




In Mathematics 100% achieved a Level 4 - 13% above National

In Reading 100% achieved a Level 4 - 11% above National

In Writing 100% achieved a Level 4 - 13% above National

In SPaG 100% achieved a Level 4



In Mathematics 73% achieved a Level 5 - 32% above National

In Reading 67% achieved a Level 5 - 19% above National

In Writing 60% achieved a Level 5 - 24% above National

In SPaG 100% achieved a Level 5





## % MAKING EXPECTED 2 LEVEL PROGRESS



In Mathematics 100% made expected 2 levels of progress - 10% above National
In Reading 100% made expected 2 levels of progress - 9% above National
In Writing 100% made expected 2 levels of progress - 6% above National
In SPaG 100% achieved a Level 5

## **% MAKING GREATER THAN EXPECTED 2 LEVEL PROGRESS**



In Mathematics 59% made greater than expected 2 levels of progress - 25% above National In Reading 48% made greater than expected 2 levels of progress - 15% above National In Writing 55% made greater than expected 2 levels of progress - 19% above National In SPaG 100% made greater than expected 2 levels of progress
