Summary of responses received from pupils from Reception to Year 6

1. Why do you enjoy/not enjoy coming to school?

Feedback – Pupils seemed to enjoy coming to school. According to most of the children, they enjoy learning and the friendly school environment.

2. Which learning activity/activities do you enjoy most at school?

Feedback – Most of the pupils seem to enjoy science and creative activities the most.

3. What activity/activities would you like to have in your classroom?

Feedback – Most of the pupils would like to have more game related learning activities in their classrooms.

4. What activity/activities would you like to have in your playground?

Feedback – Responses reflected climbing frames, monkey gym and tennis especially for the KS2 playground.

5. What do you like about your ICT suite and school library?

Feedback – Lots of the pupils liked the Education City and coding games in the ICT suite. Most of the children from Reception to Year 4 would love to visit the library and use it.

6. How can we make school more enjoyable for you?

Feedback – Pupils want more outdoor activities like monkey gym, tennis, visits to the library from all year groups, more science and sports activities.

7. Would you recommend your school to other children?

Feedback – All pupils interviewed were happy to recommend their school to other children. Some of the reasons given were; it is a good catholic school, children learn respect, we learn a lot of new things, we have nice and intelligent teachers, children are friendly and we have fun!
