The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, 5^{th} March. Let us remind ourselves what Lent is. Lent is the six-week period before Easter observed by many Christians.

It commemorates the 40 days during which Jesus fasted and resisted temptation from Satan. During Lent, Christian people tend to fast or abstain from something; they also focus their prayer for the good of others and think about those less fortunate than themselves.

Together for lent let us all try to reflect upon this thought from Pope Francis - 'During Lent, let us find concrete ways to overcome our indifference.'

Pope Francis also reminds us that 'God never tires of forgiving us; we are the ones who tire of seeking his mercy.' - When we find times are hard let us all turn to God for his Grace and Mercy.
