Dear Parents

It is hard to believe that we are almost at the end of this school year - what a year it has been! As we move towards the end of the the summer term, I would like to publicly thank and praise our children, who have shown a huge amount of resilience to overcome everything that has been thrown at them. They have had a lot to cope with!

I would also like to thank you (the parents) for your continued support and flexibility through this very difficult period. As you know, the end of this academic year will once again look very different to any other year.

In light of the continued situation, we are unable to facilitate many of the normal procedures and routines we would normally run at the end of a school year.

We understand this is hard for both pupils and parents, but we thank you in advance for your understanding, as all decisions made are to ensure that we look after all members of the SJF family.

I am sure, like us, you are all waiting to hear the changes to the COVID19 road map on the 19th July. For us at SJF, this is too late to implement any changes in school.

Having looked at our risk assessments and the worrying data about the sharp rise in COVID19 cases, we have taken the decision to keep all our safety measures in place until we break up on Thursday 22nd July.

This means the children will remain in their class bubbles and the wearing of face masks whilst on school grounds will continue.

However, there is light ahead of us - from September we plan to open as 'normal' - no restrictions on classes mixing, being able to enjoy lunch together, welcoming parents to events in school, having whole school collective worship together - for us this really means getting the SJF family back as one and not seven separate groups.


